### Registration and Coaching Sessions

The 2008 season starts with the registration evening on Friday April 18<sup>th</sup> at 7pm and coaching begins on Sunday April 20<sup>th</sup>. We hope to see you there.

ECB qualified coaches will be present at all training sessions and will be directed, as necessary by the head coach. We welcome parents to stay and assist the coaches during the sessions. The training sessions will comprise a mix of both individually monitored net training, field-craft training on the pitch or a fun but serious mini-match to practice match skills.

All Colts will be asked to register on arrival at the club and they must be collected by their 'collecting adult' after the head coach signals the completion of the training session.

## **Kit**

It is a requirement both of Beckenham & Sydenham Cricket Club and the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) that youth players (all under 18) for their own safety wear a helmet and an abdominal protector (box) when batting and a helmet when fielding close to the batsman. B&SCC do provide helmets for use as required, but we do recommend strongly that parents or guardians obtain an abdominal protector and ECB approved helmet for the personal use of their child.

All colts are required to wear a B&SCC Colts shirt, when playing in a match. Existing or new members may purchase a shirt from the club. See Stephanie McCulloch for further details.

Please ensure all your clothing and equipment has your name clearly marked on it and please remember that your personal property is your responsibility at all times. In particular keep your mobile phones safe!

## **Matches**

This coming season we have teams entered at U11s (2), U13s (2) and U15s (2) levels and U16, in the North Kent Junior League ([www.nkentjunior.play-cricket.com](http://www.nkentjunior.play-cricket.com)). Also some cup competitions. These matches will be weekly over the period April-July, for those selected to play. These matches are in addition to coaching and are at no extra charge.

Fixtures will be posted on the notice boards, in the club fixture card (when available to meet printing deadlines) and on the clubs play-cricket website.

The relevant squad/team managers run all matches in the North Kent Junior Cricket League or in the various Cup competitions entered by B&SCC, under the direction of the Junior Coordinator.

Once selected to play for any of the age group teams, the team managers will provide fixtures details, including times and venues, etc. If picked, please confirm availability ASAP with your team manager.

Help with transportation to and from away matches is much appreciated.

## **Clubhouse**

The bar will always be open to serve drinks, refreshments, sweets, hot drinks and meals (weekday lunchtimes and evenings).

The Cricket Club notice board is on the wall to the left as you enter the main entrance of the club, it shows fixture details, general news and information. The club Office is immediately to the right.

A public telephone is also situated in the entrance hall beyond the notice board and office. Please ask behind the bar or office if there are any problems.
